How to participate:

1. Send us an e-mail to erasmustagebuch@oead.at containing:
 - a. Your name
 - b. Your e-mail address
 - c. As the case may be your Facebook username
 - d. The name of your sending institution in Austria
 - e. The duration of your stay abroad
 - f. Your Erasmus+ destination country
2. Go to [Erasmus+ Diary](#) and log in with you Facebook UserID. Afterwards we will send you detailed information (in German) by e-mail and after a short registration you can start to write your Erasmus+ Diary.
3. Write down your Erasmus+ experiences into your diary for the duration of your stay abroad. You can either write in German or in English. Whether you're staying for a long or short time, you can join the competition at any time, at the latest until November 10, 2019.

Competition criteria

The criteria for winning a travel voucher are **Erasmus+ relevance** and **quality of your diary entries**.

We are especially interested in:

Why did you decide to study abroad? How did you prepare for your Erasmus+ stay?

How was your arrival? Where are you accommodated?

What challenges do you meet in your Erasmus+ everyday life? Do you attend a language course? What do you particularly like about your Erasmus+ institution?

How is your Erasmus+ school life? Which seminars do you attend at university? What are you responsible for at your Erasmus+ internship? Which adult education course do you attend? What is your project meeting about? What do you do in your spare time?

What did you learn? What kind of experiences did you gain for your future from your Erasmus+ stay abroad?

Framework requirements

Number of entries:

- If you're staying abroad one week or less write at least two diary entries.
- If you're staying abroad longer than one week write on average one diary entry per week.

Winner selection

A jury will evaluate the Erasmus+ diaries according to the above mentioned criteria and select one winner per education sector.

Prize Details

The best Erasmus+ diaries will be honoured at the Erasmus+ Award ceremony on December 3, 2019. There are four € 400 travel vouchers to win. In each education sector (school education, vocational education and training, higher education and adult education) one winner will be selected by the OeAD-GmbH.
