

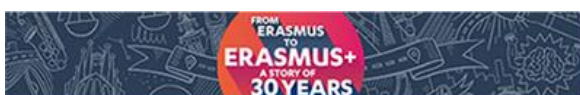

<p>VSU is ready to cooperate within mobility of teaching staff in different disciplines such as English, Russian and German Philology, History, Biology, Psychology, Physics and Mathematics. We are also interested in the mobility of administrative staff for the development of the higher education management in VSU. In terms of bachelor and master mobility (both incoming and outgoing) VSU is able to cooperate especially in the field of English and Russian Philology. As regards PhD outbound mobility, VSU can send students enrolled in English and Russian Philology, Management, Mathematics and Teacher Training. VSU is particularly interested in cooperating with Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice (especially with the department of American and English Studies), Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica, Slovakia, University of Graz (Institute of Geography and Regional Sciences, Faculty of Humanities: Departments of American and English Language and Literature), University of Vienna (Faculty of Philological and Cultural Studies), University of Debrecen (Faculty of Arts) and University of Miskolci (Faculty of Arts), as well as with other universities wishing to cooperate in both academic and administrative staff and student mobility.</p> <p>VSU can presently offer the following courses in English and Russian. <p>Vanadzor State University after H. Toumanyan is considered to be the largest HEI of Lori Region, the largest region of Armenia. Education is delivered at 5 faculties of the University: Philological Faculty, Faculty of History and Geography, Faculty of Pedagogy, Faculty of Biology and Chemistry, and Faculty of Physics and Mathematics. At present, intensive education reforms are being carried out within the frameworks of the Bologna Process, to which our country acceded in 2005. These reforms aim at integrating the University into EHEA. Since 2004, VSU has been delivering tertiary education: Bachelor's (2004), Master's (2008), Post-graduate Studies (2006). Education is based on the core principles of the ECTS. In 2015, a procedure of institutional accreditation of the university was carried out by the National Center for Professional Quality</p>			



Assurance (ANQA), as a result of which VSU has gained state accreditation for the period of 4 years. VSU is a member of 10 consortia. Today VSU has close cooperation with more than 20 major HEIs in Europe and post-soviet countries.

Since 2013, serious investments have been made to improve the level of higher education at VSU. As a result, five Tempus and four Erasmus Mundus mobility projects have been implemented at VSU. Due to Tempus projects the University has undergone positive structural changes and Erasmus Mundus mobility projects have given VSU students and staff an opportunity to gain European teaching and learning experience. Mobility at all degree levels enhanced students' motivation and self-esteem, promoted their personal and professional growth and enabled them to develop their skills in intercultural relations.

Thanks to LeAGUe and SSRULLI projects of the Tempus programme our institution has established a new unit whose main function is to deliver formal education. In 2015, an LLL Centre was established where trainings of teaching staff, foreign language courses, trainings for school directors and some vocational courses are being constantly organized.

Due to VERITAS project, VSU has developed a new PhD program as a result of which the number of VSU PhD students has considerably increased.

As regards MAHATMA project, VSU has gained a new competence- and outcome-based master academic programme in the specialization "Education Management" which was accredited by the National Centre for Professional Education Quality Assurance Foundation.

The fifth Tempus project GOVERN has granted us an opportunity for the improvement of university governance and development of good management mechanisms.

Since September, 2016 the university has been involved in the BOOST /Boosting Armenian Universities Internationalization Strategy & Marketing / national project under the priority of Governance Reform. The wider objective of the Project is to foster and promote further internationalization of Armenian Higher Education through development of national and institutional policy framework and tools.

Thanks to Erasmus Mundus four projects (EMINENCE/EMINENCE II and IANUS/IANUS II) VSU started international credit mobility in 2013 which further was transformed into bilateral cooperation in the framework of Erasmus+. At present VSU has Erasmus+ bilateral agreements on International Credit Mobility with the 5 EU universities: University of Porto, Portugal; Alexandru Ioan Cuza University, Romania; University of Granada, Spain; University of Lodz, Poland and University of Erlangen, Germany.

Our productive cooperation with the coordinating institution of the Erasmus Mundus EMINENCE project, Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan, has resulted in the implementation of another project, a "double diploma" joint master programme. Consequently, five of VSU master students are now being enrolled in the master studies at the Institute of Classical Philology. Upon completion of their two year master studies (the first year at AMU and the second one at VSU) they will receive two diplomas being awarded a degree of M.A. in Philology with the specialization in Mediterranean studies.

The university pays great attention to the development and improvement of foreign language skills of students and staff. For that reason, different language courses at different language levels are being suggested to them.

The chair of foreign languages greatly contributes to this initiative and organizes different courses, several scientific conferences and seminars in Teacher Training and Linguistics. Staff members constantly develop new theoretical courses, design curricula, issue new scientific and methodological materials for teaching languages at universities and schools.

The chair is currently concerned with the implementation of innovative assessment tools and mechanisms, more specifically the design and implementation of different analytic rubrics for evaluating students' individual work. Students of the English Department are actively involved in the rubric development processes. One of the priorities of this kind of evaluation is that it enhances the objectivity level of student performance evaluation and that students become experienced in peer- and self-evaluation.

Teaching foreign languages is also provided at the Lifelong Learning Centre of VSU where 5 languages are taught at different language levels (English, French, German, Russian and Spanish). Due to modern teaching methods and materials, students of different specialties enrolled in the language courses have an opportunity to acquire new foreign languages and improve their language skills.

In conclusion, it is worth mentioning that the university is taking serious steps for positive changes and we do anticipate new ideas and new challenges which can open new perspectives for the improvement of higher education.

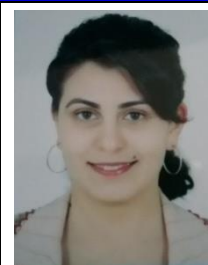
